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QUESTIONNAIRE

I, _____ agree to the following terms and conditions for fostering one or more pets from Geelong Animal Welfare Society.

Terms and conditions:

- * Have the permits, where required by local government, to keep the number of animals at the premises.
- * Not have more animals requiring foster in care at any one time from another organisation.
- * Notify the establishment immediately and present the animal to a veterinary practitioner if symptoms of illness develop while in your care.
- * Provide a safe and secure environment with environmental enrichment and socialisation for foster animals.
- * Provide a well-balanced nutritious diet for the foster animal and abide by feeding requirements if given from the establishment or veterinary practitioner.
- * Follow any veterinary instructions on medication or treatment regimes as directed by the establishment's veterinary practitioner for the animal in care.
- * Follow any training or exercise plans as instructed by a veterinary practitioner or the establishment.
- * Ensure the animals leaving the premises are in a crate or restrained by a leash that is held by the approved foster carer or a person designated in the written agreement as being able to control the animal.
- * Agree to keep all animals appropriately leashed and contained while in foster care in any surroundings other than the home.
- * Agree to keep all cats and kittens inside your premises at all times during foster care.
- * Return the animal from foster care to the establishment within the specified time set in the foster care agreement.
- * Understand the risk of potential damages made by foster animals to you or your personal property and acknowledge that the establishment cannot be held accountable.
- * Never to leave the foster animal in someone else's care unless approved by the establishment.
- * Understand that fostering is strictly in a voluntary capacity, and that any expenses are covered by the foster carer unless stated and approved in writing by the establishment.

In addition, foster carers conducting juvenile, veterinary rehabilitation or behavioural rehabilitation foster care for the establishment must:

- * Be trained or experienced to care for and meet the needs of the animals placed in their care for rehabilitation.
- * Keep the animals and their records in accordance with the instructions of the written foster agreement.
- * Present the animal and all related records to the veterinary practitioner or relevant supervisor as requested or required by the establishment.
- * Acknowledge that the animal is the property of the Geelong Animal Welfare Society, and return the foster animal whenever required or requested to do so.
- * If at any stage the animal escapes, or is at large, you need to notify the Geelong Animal Welfare Society immediately.
